

Sightseeing Tram Tours in Prague

Routes

1. Standard route

We have selected two standard routes for you to take to see the most beautiful places in Prague:

Variant A

Vozovna Střešovice – Hradčanská – Strossmayerovo náměstí – Náměstí Republiky – Václavské náměstí – Národní třída – Národní divadlo – Staroměstská – Malostranská – Pražský hrad – Pohořelec – Myslbekova – Vozovna Střešovice.

Variant B

Vozovna Střešovice – Pražský hrad – Malostranská – Právnická fakulta – Náměstí Republiky – Václavské náměstí – Národní třída – Národní divadlo – Újezd – Malostranská – Pražský hrad - Pohořelec – Myslbekova – Vozovna Střešovice.

Meeting place: Střešovice Depot

Duration: 1 hour

2. Customised route

Your starting point can be anywhere on the tram network in Prague. Where you go from there is up to you. The normal duration of the ride is one hour, but we will be happy to arrange a longer route for you upon request.

The price of the ride is charged for every hour commenced, from when the tram departs from Střešovice Depot (Patočkova 4, Prague 6) until it returns to the Depot.

Thanks to over a hundred-year history of urban public transport in Prague, you can choose from a wide range of tram cars to take a sightseeing tour.



Historic tram

Let yourself be carried away by the flow of time to the idyllic beginnings of the twentieth century. At the times when the Praguers were riding this Ringhoffer vehicle, ladies wore crinolines and hats with feathers from birds-of-paradise and import tax on goods was collected at Florenc. The oldest motor car of Prague's public transport has been on the streets of Prague since 1908.

Towed tramcar

Every native Praguer could jump in and out of the tram while riding. This is no longer permissible today, of course, but the atmosphere of the end of the Austro-Hungarian era can be also reminded by riding this tram. Together with the original tram, it offers enough space for 60 people!

T3 Coupé sightseeing tram

The Prague Public Transit Company (PPTC) in cooperation with Anna Marešová designers created a new concept of a cruise tram that follows the traditions of the legendary Tatra T3 tram. The tram preserves the poetics of the 1960s thereby commending the designer František Kardaus (1908-1986), who was the author of the original Tatra T3 tram. The designers were most inspired by the original T3, but in search for the new design and new interior and exterior solutions they were also visiting depots and searched for old flashlights, spotlights and other elements in warehouses. The interior also features a bar, which comes from the T1 tram, where a similar desk was used for selling the tickets. The designers have not forgotten the original ticket marking machine to be on the tram, as passengers obtain an original T3 Coupé ticket every time for their journey. The tram offers a pleasure not only from a ride in Prague in a semi-open car, but it also provides an experience of the stylish interior.
